Clean Hands

Swine flu has reminded us about hand-washing this year. In Uganda it is one of the cheapest solutions to poor health, reducing disease by half according to the World Health Organisation. Your gift will keep one school stocked with soap for a month.

School Bags

Many of the children currently carry their books, pens and, more importantly, medicine, to and from school in their pockets or a torn old carrier bag. Your gift will provide one child with their own school bag to ensure that their medicine makes it home safely. Each bag will carry a key health message too!

One mosquito net will keep a child safe from biting mosquitoes and malaria every night of the year. Your gift will provide a three year old nursery child with their own net and proper training in how to use it.
